

Community Rail and...



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Led by the Devon & Cornwall Rail Partnership, the €9 million project has partners in the UK, France, Germany and the Netherlands. It is providing more frequent services, station improvements, community engagement and local marketing campaigns.

In the UK, Citizens' Rail has enabled the construction of a new locally owned station building at Burnley Manchester Road that is playing a major part in the town's regeneration, alongside the return of direct trains to Manchester.

In the South West, the project is injecting new energy into the Riviera Line (Exeter-Paignton). Additional services, improved stations, volunteer groups, school engagement and a major marketing campaign have helped the line to bounce back stronger than before following 2014's devastating storms.

Through regular site visits and meetings with the French, Dutch and German partners, new perspectives have emerged to help the community rail sector to continue to develop and learn.

The project runs from May 2012 to September 2015 and is 50% funded by the EU Interreg IVB North West Europe programme.



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
